

First, let's examine the choices you have. You are free to believe there is a Hell, believe there isn't a Hell, and you are free to ignore or decline to think about it altogether.

You can believe there is a Hell and still go there.

You can believe there is not a Hell and still go there.

Lastly, you can choose not to think about Hell, the "after life," Heaven, God, Jesus, Salvation, your eternal soul, which is a choice in and of itself; you will still go there.

The Bible (God's Word) says, For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness....
I Corinthians 1:18a

Practical excuses that will send you to Hell:

- 1) I'm a good person. Ephesians 2:8-9**
- 2) I go to church. Acts 4:12**
- 3) I am Catholic, Baptist, Lutheran, etc. Gal. 2:21**
- 4) I give to charities. John 3:3**
- 5) A loving God would not let anyone go to Hell. John 3:16-18**
- 6) I was baptized. Matthew 3:2-6**
- 7) I pray. Matthew 6:5-13**
- 8) I'm going to trust God before I die. II Corinthians 6:2**
- 9) I can't break my bad habits. Galatians 6:1**
- 10) I have done too many bad things; God could not forgive me. John 3:16**

What do I do?

I don't want to go to Hell when I die!

If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God raised Him From the dead, thou shalt be saved...For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Romans 10:9,13

Pray this prayer (or your own words) and mean it:

Dear God, I know that Jesus is Your Son, and He died on the cross and was raised from the dead to pay for my sin and save me. Because I have sinned and need forgiveness, I ask Jesus to come into

my heart. I am willing to change the direction of my life and follow Him as Lord and Savior. Thank You for forgiving me and giving me eternal Life. In Jesus' name, Amen.

If you prayed that prayer and meant it, find a Bible-believing fellowship to learn and grow in your new relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

The rest of the story: For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

I Corinthians 1:18

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the

world; but that the world through Him might be saved. He that believeth on Him is not condemned;

but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:16-18
